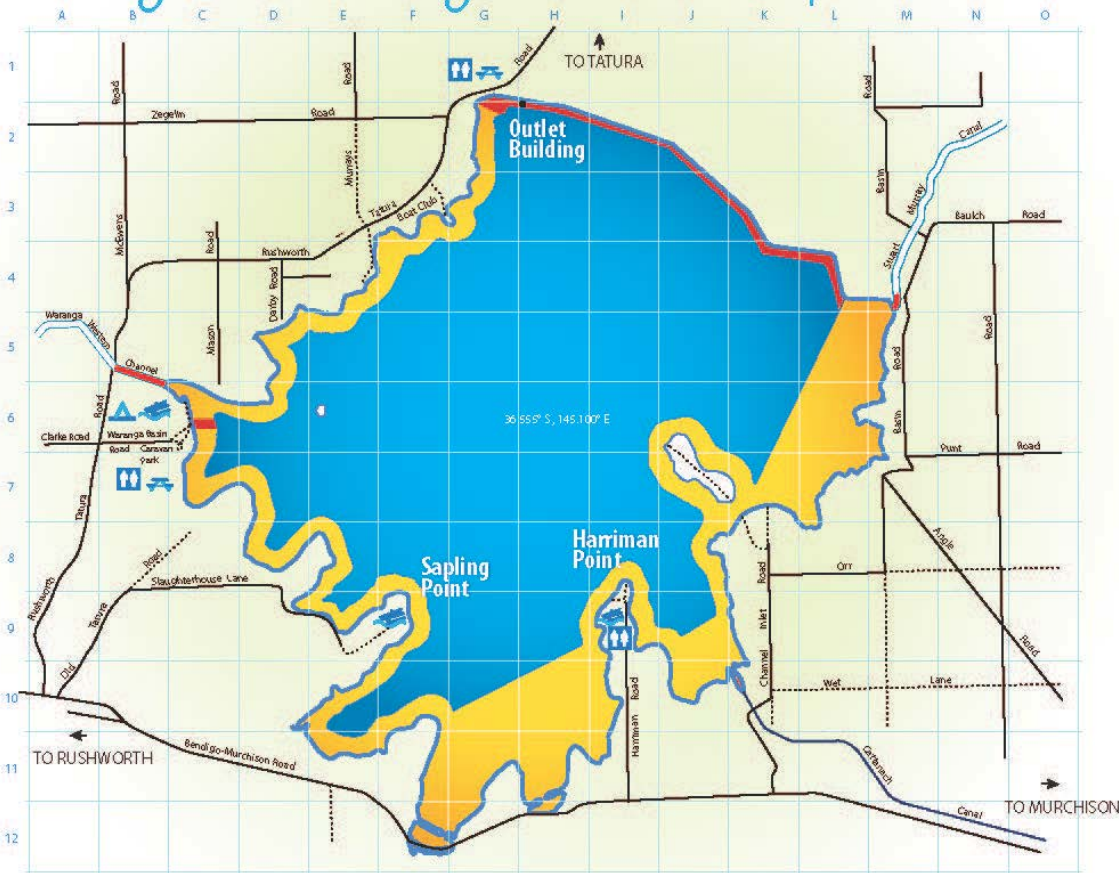

**Guidelines**

You can help protect Waranga Basin and enhance the enjoyment and safety of others by following these simple guidelines:

- Help keep sites around Waranga Basin clean and protect the environment by taking your rubbish home with you.
- Vehicles and motorbikes may be used on roads open to public use only. All vehicles must be registered and or road, it cannot be used by speed limits.
- A Motor Boat Licence is required when operating a motorised boat in Victorian waters.
- All plants, animals and other items introduced by law enforcement must be removed or destroyed.
- Your safety is important. If you need an emergency assistance take note of your location according to the grid numbers on this map.
- Water is not suitable for human consumption.
